### **THE MONTCLAIR ART MUSEUM ORGANIZES COLLECTING ART: AN AFFORDABLE ART FAIR AND TWELVE CADILLACS CLASSIC CAR SHOW**

MONTCLAIR, NJ, May 11, 2011 — The Montclair Art Museum will hold its first art fair, *Collecting Art: An Affordable Art Fair*, on Saturday, June 11, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. and on Sunday June 12, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. in conjunction with the exhibition *Warhol and Cars: American Icons*. The fair will take place in MAM's Leir Hall. *Collecting Art* aims to offer an outlet for the sale of artworks made by emerging artists from the NY/NJ metropolitan region and also to promote the affordable collecting of contemporary art for visitors. Artists will offer their works between the price range of \$50 and \$500. MAM will offer free admission to *Collecting Art* and half price admission to the Museum galleries throughout the weekend.
